STEM Apprenticeship Opportunities for High School Students

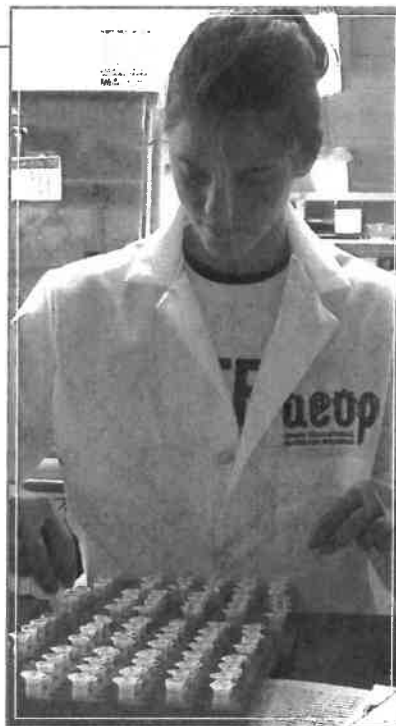
Research & Engineering Apprenticeship Program (REAP)
