

Hello Counselors!

Happy New Year and best wishes for a happy and academically awesome year!

Memorial Hospital is pleased to let you know about two separate programs that we will be bringing to your students this year. The first is the Junior Medical School program (repeated from last year) and NEW to the offerings is the UCHealth Group Career Exploration program. Both programs are detailed below.

Junior Medical School – JMS is a 3-day, immersive program designed to give your students a full view of the many different aspects of a healthcare career. It is available to junior and senior students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher who have an interest in a healthcare career. (And yes, 2018 graduated seniors may apply!) There will be 4 sessions, 15 students per session running in June, July and August, for a total of 60 students in the program.

UCHealth Career Exploration program - This program is a one day event that focuses on those students who are interested in a healthcare career not requiring a 4-year college degree. These career opportunities are in the clinic setting, ranging from running a clinic to Medical Assistants to Surgical Schedulers. This program is for your senior students (ONLY) with a GPA of 3.0 or higher who have an interest in a healthcare career. (And again, 2018 graduated seniors may apply!) There will be three sessions, 12 students per session running in April, July and August, for a total of 36 students in the program.
